She has served as President of Women in Film and Television in NSW and nationally, chaired the Australian Cinematographers Society Women's Advisory Panel and mentored numerous emerging women cinematographers and filmmakers.

She also teaches university students the art and science of cinematography where she passionately aims to inspire and encourage women students to follow her footsteps into the world behind the camera.

Erika's work recognises and promotes the power and importance of women's point of view behind the camera in the creation of moving images to tell powerful stories.
