Heather Reid has had 30 years experience in sport as a player, volunteer, mentor and leader at club, state and national levels. As a pioneer, particularly in football, which has become the fastest growing women's sport, she has dedicated herself to achieving gender equity for women in sport.

Heather's many accomplishments include: founding member of the Australian National University Women's Soccer; introducing women's state representative teams; securing the first contract for a female to play soccer overseas; developing the GET YOUR KICKS FROM SOCCER girls' programme, establishing pathways through to the MATILDAS; pioneering the establishment of the Women's World Cup; initiating the BUSINESS WOMEN AND SPORT lunch series; leading the amalgamation of Women's Soccer Canberra with Soccer Canberra; and successfully advocating for increased media coverage and sponsorship for women in sport. She is the first female CEO of a State football federation.
