She was instrumental in organising International Women's Day Celebrations in 2014, is the chairperson of Detour House, a rehabilitation centre for drug dependent women, and works directly as a counsellor and group leader in the WOMEN PARTNERS OF BISEXUAL MEN PROJECT.

For the last six months, Roxanne has been at the forefront of the SOS WOMEN'S SERVICES CAMPAIGN to save Women's Specialist Homelessness Services in the Inner Sydney Area. Because of her unshakable determination, there is hope that the services may be funded for a further three years.
