She established and curates the Northern Sydney Aboriginal Artist exhibitions highlighting the work of Aboriginal women.

Clair has worked for decades behind the scenes to ensure that the art of Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander women is represented in the regions.

Clair continues to be an active participant in the Regional Reconciliation Network of which she was co-chair for 6 years.
